

CAUTION

Store steel panels in a dry place. Stand them on end against an interior wall and fan out at the bottom, to provide positive air circulation and moisture run-off. If panels must be stacked, they should be kept off the ground on wooden blocks or strips in an inclined position in a dry place.

The panels should be stored outside only when it is **ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY** and then only for short periods of time. The use of canvas or waterproof paper should be used only when allowing for ventilation. Plastic tarps, which may cause sweating and condensation and trap moisture, should never be used.

If these precautions are not taken and moisture is trapped in the panel, superficial staining may occur. When moisture remains in the bundle of panels for a considerable time, wet-storage stains can occur, reducing the effective life of the panel.
